Wildlife and Birdlife Walk with grazing picnic Ice Breaker for Couples

Your personal EcoWalks guide will walk you to some of Sydney Harbour foreshore scenic vantage points within Sydney Harbour National Park including Middle Headland Peninsula on your Wildflower and Birdlife Walk. This walk takes you along the bushland trails to visit the diverse range of native flora and fauna. The bushland here includes native herbs, shrubs and trees which include acacias, banksias as well as eucalyptus trees like the Smooth-Bark Apple Tree, otherwise known as the Sydney Red Gum.

Highlights:

Start: 1801 Fort Track Mosman. Bushland walk to Middle Headland King Bungaree Farm Wildflower walk to Middle Head Inner Fortification Birdlife walk to Middle Head Outer Fortification Tales of Captain Barry Pettersen and the Tiger Cages of Middle Head Bushland walk to the 1801 Fortification Obelisk Bay Beach lookout and Don Goodsir Boardwalk.
